Cone Chair

Originally designed for a Danish restaurant, the Cone Chair takes its shape from the classic geometric figure for which it is named. The cone-shaped seat is mounted at its point on a stainless steel swivel base. A semi-circular padded shell extends upward to form the back and armrests, thereby creating a very

comfortable armchair. The matching Cone Stool is an ideal companion for the Cone Chair as well as the Cone Table, yet it also makes a striking solo piece.

#### Materials

- Body: GRP (glass fibre reinforced plastic laminate).
- Upholstery: lightly padded with polyurethane foam. Seat cushion.
- Base: stainless steel cruciform base, satin finish.
- Glides: plastic.


